Year 1

- Compare and order numbers to 20 and 50.
- Recognising place value of a two-digit number.
- Identify one more and one less.
- · Addition and subtraction of numbers to 20 and 50.
- Measurement.

Year 2

- \cdot Money recognising £ and p, combine amounts of money, find different combinations of coins that equal the same amount, solve problems which includes giving change.
- Multiplication and division.

Computing

<u>Information Technology Around Me</u>

This term the children will be learning how to program a robot to make it move. They will use up to four commands and will be able to predict the outcome of their programming. The children will use directional language and programming skills to support their learning.

Year 1 and 2 Curriculum Spring 2022

English


Year 1 This half term the children will be working on sentence structure and combining two sentences using the conjunction 'and'. They will continue to improve their use of capital letters and full stops in their sentences.

Year 2 This half term the children will be learning how to use a variety of conjunctions in their writing. They will be learning to use questions and commands in their sentence writing, using the correct punctuation to support this. They will also be learning about adverbs.

The children's writing this term will be based around books which support our topic 'Our Country' — these include Paddington, Coming to England and the Naughty Bus.

Our Country

This term our topic will be all about our country. The children will be able to locate the four countries which make up the UK and their capitals. They will be researching facts about these countries and will be locating and naming the main rivers in the UK. The children will compare local landmarks to London landmarks and be able to understand the differences between human and physical Geography. In DT the children will be planning, designing, testing and building a stable structure to house a London bus.



Science

Animals including humans

This half term the children will be identifying various common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. They will be identifying which animals are carnivores, herbivores or omnivores and they will be able to identify which parts of the human body are linked to each of the senses.

PSHE

Keeping myself safe

This half term the children will be looking at how they can keep themselves safe and healthy. They will discuss healthy eating and exercise, good sleep hygiene, feelings associated with loss, what to do if they feel unsafe and internet safety.

Music

How have Kings & Queens ruled Britain?

Composition — Musical Patterns

Percussion — to play tuned and un-tuned instruments.

<u>PE</u>

Locomotion Running - Developing children's' ability to run using different parts of their bodies. They will begin to understand the basic principles of attack and defence as they develop their understanding of where we need to run and why.

Jumping - Developing children's understanding of how and why we jump, using our head, arms and feet, applying the correct jumping technique. They will begin to understand the different reasons when, where and why we jump in different ways.
