Creative	What causes a volcano to erupt?
	This is a collage/painting by an artist called Margaret Godfrey. She has stuck down strips of scrunched tissue to create texture and then painted over it. If you make your paint watery you can dab it on and then blow through a straw to make the lava eruption! When it's dry you can always draw extra details like boulders in. Artists like Margaret Godfrey plan their work out before they start. Draw your volcano on paper before you begin. Make sure you include all the parts of the volcano (crust, outer core, lava, magma) in your plan. Your task is to create your own volcanic layered artwork inspired by the work of artist Margaret Godfrey.
