



Year 1 and 2 Curriculum Summer 2022

Maths

Year 1


- Finding halves and quarters
- Direction - describing positions and turns
- Time – telling time to the hour and half past
- Money – recognising notes and coins

Year 2

- Direction – describing movement and turns
- Problem solving – using number
- Weight, volume and temperature

English

This term we will be focussing our Literacy activities on the book “The Rainbow Bear”. We will use this to support our writing of poetry, a newspaper report and a fact file.



Year 1 children will continue to develop their skills in the use of capital letters, full stops, adjectives and a variety of conjunctions. They will also look at adding prefixes and suffixes to words as well as consolidating their knowledge of creating good sentences.

Year 2 will be focussing on consolidating the literacy skills they have developed throughout the year.

Science

The Environment

★ During this unit the children will learn about climate change, how to recycle and different types of energy and how these affect our planet. They will also look at how rainforests are affected and how and why we need to save water to help the planet.

Computing

Making Music

★ In this unit, children will be using a computer to create music. They will listen to a variety of pieces of music and consider how music can make them think and feel. Learners will compare creating music digitally and non-digitally. Learners will look at patterns and purposefully create music.

Poles Apart

★ In this topic the children will learn about how the weather varies across the globe as well as discussing hot and cold climates and locating these on a map. We will also discuss how changes in weather affects us.

We will compare the Polar regions, how to locate these on a map and discuss similarities and differences between the Arctic and the Antarctic, looking at temperature and animals found in these areas.

In design technology, the children will be evaluating, designing and making a pair of gloves that could be used on a trip to the poles.

PSHE

★ The children will be learning that the names for a boy's and girl's external genitals and these are the names we would use if we had to talk to a Doctor or someone else we trust about our private parts. They will also discuss the NSPCC Underwear rule and that what's in their pants belongs only to them, which is why we cover them up. They will also be talking about what babies need and how to meet the basic needs of a baby and how these change. There will also be lessons on what to do if they are asked to keep a secret and they feel uncomfortable about it.

Music

Listening

★ Children will learn to recognise repeated patterns and follow a range of musical instructions using appropriate language. They will begin to represent sounds with simple sounds including shapes and marks. They will look at samba and performing a calypso.

PE

Athletics and Games

★ Children will learn and progress in their skills in a number of athletic events including running, jumping and throwing ready for sports day. They will also develop their skills in different games. They will develop their ability to apply the principles of attack vs defence, with a particular focus on creating simple attacking tactics in order to move the ball up the court, creating an attack that results in a shooting opportunity.

RE

Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?

★ This term the children will be learning about the Islamic religion. We will explore Allah, the Prophet Mohammed, Shahadah, what happens in a Mosque and Muslim holy words.
