## Physical Development

★ Moving (Gymnastics)

The unit of work will explore 'champion gymnastics'. Pupils will create movements and balances in big and small ways on the floor and on apparatus. Pupils will work in pairs to explore creating movements and balances with a partner.

★ Locomotion (Walking)

The unit of work will explore walking using different body parts in different directions, at different levels and at different speeds. Pupils will learn how to apply their walking skills into games.
