Computing

The Internet

Children will apply their knowledge and understanding of networks, to appreciate the internet as a network of networks which need to be kept secure. They will learn that the World Wide Web is part of the internet, and be given opportunities to explore it for themselves. Pupils will evaluate online content - how honest, accurate, or reliable it is, and understand the consequences of false information.

<u>PE</u>

Health and Wellbeing

The children will learn how to execute meditative balances and relaxation techniques to help combat feelings of anxiety. They will gain an awareness of how to apply these techniques in day-to-day life.

Basketball

The unit of work will explore how to apply the principles of attack vs defence, with a particular focus on passing and moving, dribbling and shooting. The children will learn how to keep possession and eventually score in order to win a modified game.

Would you prefer to live in the Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age?

The children will look at the Stone Age settlement of Skara Brae, learn about early settlements and compare settlements in the Neolithic and Iron Age. They will look at how bronze was better than stone and how it transformed farming.

Art:

Painting: Prehistoric Painting

The children will develop an understanding of prehistoric manmade art and explore how natural products produce pigments to make different colours. They will select and apply a range of painting techniques when creating collaborative artwork.

Music

Singing & Tuned Percussion

Children will consolidate and develop awareness of rhythm, pulse, pitch and to extend reading of standard and non-standard music notation.



Science

Group and Classify Living Things

Children will identify, sort and group animals into categories based on their features. They will group animals based on easily identifiable features. The children will use classification keys to classify plants based on simple physical characteristics.

Me and My Relationships

The children will be learning about cooperation and friendships: understanding that we don't always agree with each other. They will also explore different ways to make up with a friend if they have fallen out.

The children will make links between the story of Noah and how we live in school and the wider world.
