In this Topic, the children will look at the Stone Age settlement of Skara Brae, learn about early settlements and compare settlements in the Neolithic and Iron Age. They will look at how bronze was better than stone and how it transformed farming.

Research

The Java Man is the name given to fossils discovered in 1891 at Trinil, Indonesia. One of the first known specimens of human. This is one of the oldest fossils to date and was an extremely famous find.



Your task: Your task is to research The Java Man and write a fact file or short report about your findings.

Creative

Stone Age Cave Art: In the Stone Age people would create artwork on cave walls known as cave art. It is largely thought this was done to tell stories of hunts and communicate with other tribes. The paintings often included handprints, animals and hunters.



Your task is to design and create your own piece of cave art. The prehistoric people used to use natural looking colours such as brown, beige, black and red. You can use a range of mediums like pastel, crayon, chalk or paint. Don't forget to tea stain your paper so it looks authentic!
