Singing number songs and rhymes with your children (such as Ten Green Bottles) really helps their mathematical development. The children also love to sing along to 'The Big Numbers Song' on Youtube!

## <u>Nursery</u>

In the second half term, children in nursery will be learning to discriminate between different instrumental sounds by playing lots of exciting games involving different musical instruments!

### Reception

In the second half term of the year children will be introduced to simple adjectives when writing their own poems about the Northern Lights, will follow and give instructions to the Snow Queen and will write their words to The Snowman story.

## Communication and Language

★ Our focus stories this half term will be The Gruffalo's Child, One Snowy Night and Stickman. Again, children will be encouraged to use resources in our classroom to act out and retell these stories, using lots of lovely story language in

their play.



## Understanding of the World

★ During the next few weeks, as well as taking part in 'experiments from the Snow Queen's spell book, the children will be learning about the habitats of polar animals, about the Northern Lights and will be conducting experiments to discover the best way to free animals trapped in blocks of ice!

### Physical Development

★ Children will be taking part in Locomotion theme lessons: jumping focus and we will be using number rhymes as a theme for their parachute games which will help to support their gross motor development.
