Music - Year 3 and 4

Music is taught by specialist staff from Tees Valley Music Service during this phase of school.

Children learn ukulele as part of a group. They have a lesson every week and the teacher ensures that there is development and progression using her professional expertise.

Key aspects of the music curriculum in LKS2:

Children are taught to:

- Sing a broad range of unison songs with the range of one octave.
- Learn to play a melodic instrument.
- Perform melodies following staff notation using a small range of notes.
- Develop improvisation skills and compose short, on the sport responses using a limited note range.
- Listen to and describe live and recorded music.

In addition to this provision, children receive singing through a weekly worship session and are able to access school band as a lunchtime club in school.
