Choose one activity from the research section and one activity from the creative section to complete. *No cakes as homework this term please!

Research

- Complete the activity Compare Deserts on Seesaw to find out more about the Sahara and Antarctic.
- Write a report about a desert.

You could imagine you are an explorer who has been commissioned to write a report about their experiences in the desert. Include details about what the environment around you is like and what animals you see (with details of their adaptions for survival). *Additional information for this task is available as an activity on Seesaw.

If you prefer, you could create a presentation about a desert that includes information about features, animals and plants and ways that humans use the desert.

Creative

Look at some images of desert landscapes and draw, sketch or paint a desert landscape. Alongside this artwork, create a bank of words/adjectives to describe the scene.

Draw a picture of an animal (real or imaginary) that has adapted to survive in a desert. What features does it have?
