# Nursery

- Exploring seasonal changes.

# Reception

 Exploring maps to identify and name familiar features. Exploring the outdoors and the changes in seasons.

# Communication and Language Nurseru

- Listens and engages in small group discussions.
- Remembers simple stories with pictures.
- Shows understanding of experiences or events.
- Describes actions or experiences in the present tense.
- Tells short stories or anecdotes.

# Reception.

- Participates in conversations using new vocabulary and uses talk for play, thinking, collaboration, and expressing ideas.
- Describes events in detail and uses talk to solve problems and explain processes.
- Retells familiar stories using exact repetition and own words, learning rhymes, poems, and songs.
- Discusses nonfiction texts to develop knowledge and vocabulary.

# Nursery

- Creates collaboratively, composes music, engages with dance and performing arts, and develops roleplay storylines.
