What does the Census tell us about the Local Area?

Children will explore the census as a source of evidence and gather information about our local area. They will learn about the history of the census and how that informs us to the present day.



RE

What does it mean for a Jewish person to follow God?

Children will identify and explain Jewish beliefs about God, give examples of Jewish texts that explain this, make connections between belief about the Torah and how Jews live. They will consider why these beliefs are important to Jewish people today.

Science

Animals Including Humans

Looking at human development, the growth of babies, puberty in humans and animals, changes in old age, gestation periods & life expectancy.

Life Cycles

Learning about how plants and mammals reproduce and comparing life cycles of different animals.

PSHE

Anger

Recognising healthy and unhealthy anger and how to manage this.

Image Sharing

Using knowledge from police to stay safe online.

Music

Theme & Variation – Pop Art

Children will learn to explore the musical concept of theme and variations through studying the piece The Young Person's Guide to the Orchestra. They will use complex rhythms to perform themes and use visual representations of these.

PE

Invasion games: Netball

Children will develop advanced skills like passing, shooting, and defending. They'll learn about positions, teamwork, and game tactics through drills and matches.

Striking & Fielding: Cricket

Focus will be on refining batting, bowling, and fielding techniques. Children will practice various skills and engage in match scenarios to understand strategies and rules.
