Talk Boost Time: fun, interactive group activities focused on developing key early language skills such as attention, listening, vocabulary, and sentence-building in a supportive environment.

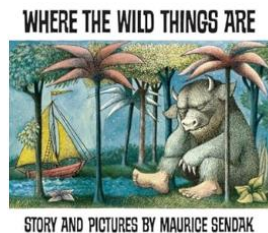
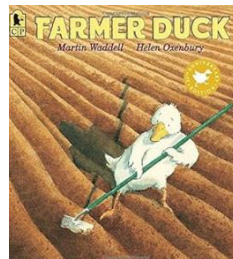

Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others. Writing sentences using a range of tricky words that are spelt correctly. Beginning to use full stops, capital letters and finger spaces. Using familiar texts as a model for writing own stories.

Music

- ★ **Transport-** Using voices, bodies and instruments to explore different types of transport, identify and mimic transport sounds and interpret and perform a simple score.
