Communication and Language

Nursery - Can describe how they carried out an activity or made a model. Understands simple who, what and where questions. Understands 'how' and 'why' questions

Reception. - Express their ideas and feelings about their experiences using full sentences, including use of past, present and future tenses and making use of conjunctions, with modelling and support from their teacher







Physical Development

Nursery:

<u>Fine motor-</u> Able to use one handed tools and equipment with control.

<u>Gross motor-</u> Uses cross lateral movement to move forward and negotiate space when moving through tunnels or dens, and when on made or created vehicle.

Reception

Fine motor

Hold a pencil effectively in preparation for fluent writing and begin to show accuracy and care when drawing.

<u>Gross Motor</u> - Move energetically, such as running, jumping, dancing, hopping, skipping, and climbing.
